

## SPEEDING TRAFFIC PROBLEMS

Having received a request for the Parish Council to contact the police about the speed of traffic along the Armscote Road, this was done, and P.C. Richard Grove of Shipston police responded.

PC GROVE is the only Police Officer stationed at Shipston and is accompanied by two Police Community Support Officers PCSO Andrew STEVENTON and PCSO Hayley DITCHBURN, The team is consequently in charge of a large number of parishes and a very extensive geographical area, therefore it is not feasible for the small team to address all speeding issues across the “patch” at one time.

However should parishes wish to have traffic speed monitored by the team they should send a petition signed by as many parishioners as possible to Shipston Police station, West Street, Shipston On Stour, Warwickshire, CV36 4HD.

These are then considered and on a three monthly basis are heard at the Shipston Community Forum, the top three have their raised issue or concern monitored and actioned for the following quarter.

P.C. Grove suggested that Ilmington submit such a petition by the end of February, and if it is in the top three then he hoped the traffic speed could be monitored during March to May.
